

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

Joel 2:23-32 NIV; Pew Bible Page 1416

Be glad, O people of Zion, rejoice in the Lord your God. for he has given you the autumn rains in righteousness. He sends you abundant showers. both autumn and spring rains, as before. The threshing floors will be filled with grain; the vats will overflow with new wine and oil. "I will repay you for the years the locusts have eaten the great locust and the young locust, the other locusts and the locust swarm – my great army that I sent among you. You will have plenty to eat, until you are full, and you will praise the

name of the Lord your God. who has worked wonders for you; never again will my people be shamed. Then you will know that I am in Israel. that I am the Lord your God. and that there is no other; never again will my people be ashamed. "And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. To some who were confident of their own righteousness and looked down on everybody else, Jesus told this parable: "Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee stood up and prayed about himself: 'God, I thank you that I am not like other men—robbers, evildoers, adulterers—or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week and give a tenth of all I get.'

"But the tax collector stood at a distance. He would not even look up to heaven, but beat his breast and said, 'God, have mercy on me, a sinner.'

"I tell you that this man, rather than the other, went home justified before God. For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."
